**How it would enhance Worton?**

It records a major Worton community event. It motivated people in Wiltshire far beyond Worton and Marston to commemorate the end of WW1 and to research their family history relating to the Great War.

50 Copies to be distributed for free to those directly involved in the event.

50 Copies for sale at nominal cost to others. (Proceeds to Worton Christ Church and Village Hall).

**Run by the community, for the community**– how will you generate community involvement, engagement and ownership both in its set up and operation?

The event involved numerous local people from Worton and Marston. Also groups such as Rose & crown Knit Natt group, Village Hall, 5 lanes school, Christ Church.

**Geographical location** – the service/project being funded should benefit the parish of Worton, but initiatives serving a wider area may be considered at the discretion of the Council.

Also involved the Devizes Royal British Legion, Wiltshire Radio (came to the village and interviewed the organisers). Contribution also came from other local villages. A power-point record of the event and scans of documents are being used by Devizes Town Council of a WW1 exhibition.

**Environmental benefit** – for example, the project may be creating a nature area or installing energy efficiency/ renewable generating equipment on a community building.
